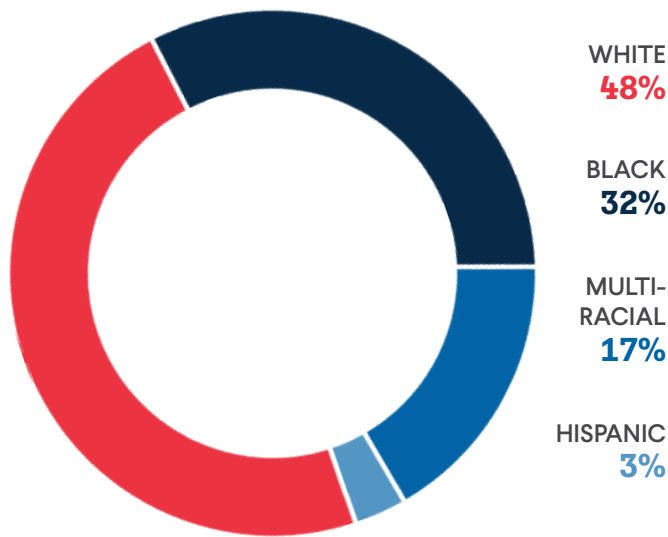

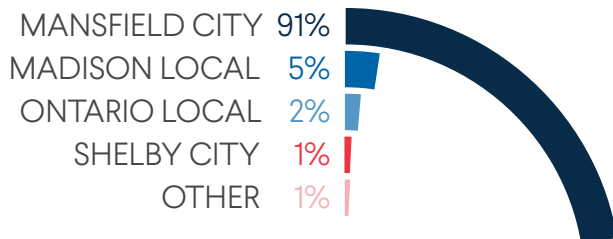

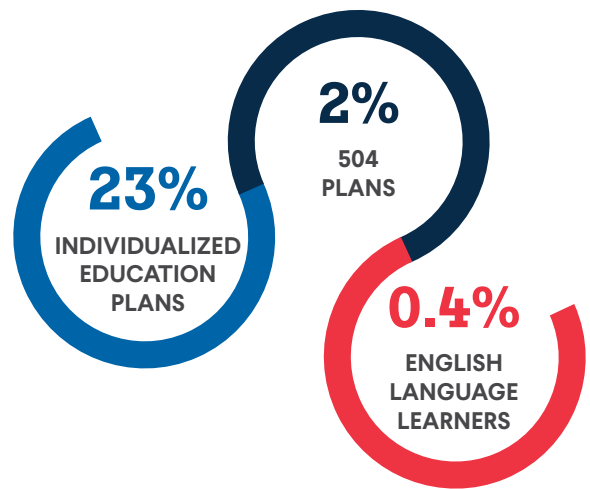
DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

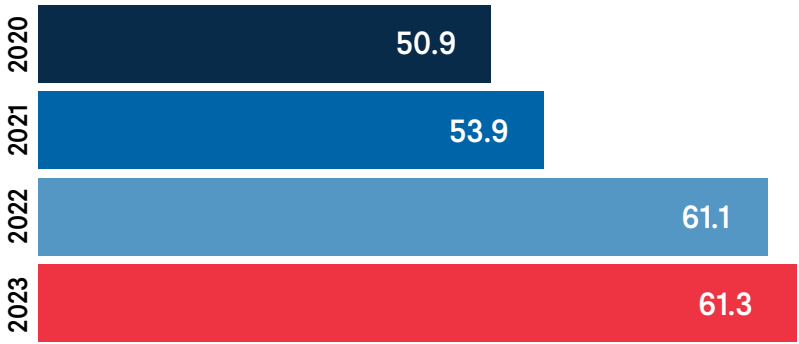

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Through a well-rounded curriculum that engages students and instructional hours above state requirements, Foundation Academy is continuing a steady academic recovery since the pandemic.
