"Annual transportation request" Packet information for 2023-2024

This packet has been updated for you to assist in all the changes coming forward for the upcoming school year. Inside, you will find the helpful items to assist you. Please remember that Madison Local Schools does not guarantee transportation services. The RFT is a request for **CONSIDERATION** of transportation services. Besides required documentation to be submitted a student must meet the minimum requirements of being over 2.0 miles and under 30-minutes travel time. **Madison Local Schools does not transport pre-school students, nor will we transport to public daycare facilities outside our district.**

An ATR **MUST** be completed **EVERY** school year and at any time that there is a change to school of attendance, new address, and/or change in custody. Madison Local Schools does not assume a student will need transportation services nor that there were no changes from the previous year.

Please note: Student changes during the school year or new students enrolling during the year may take up to 14 days to being routed.

ATR SHEET INFORMATION

This document is pretty much self-explanatory, forms should be filled out with date of request, school attending, student's full name (printed legibly) and grade. The students' home address and what services will be needed for example AM/PM or both. The guardian's name contact numbers and an e-mail address.

To receive transportation serves we need to have (4) things annually from caregivers.

- Annual transportation request(attached for your convenience)
- Proof of residency
- Emergency medical form
- Signed document indicating acknowledgement of bus safety rules. Attached for your convenience

Anytime a student has a change of address, school of attendance, and change in guardianship, or **phone number, Madison Local Schools must be notified.**

Policy for transportation during bad weather:

If we are closed due to inclement weather, for the safety of all involved we will <u>Not</u> transport students at all that day. If we are delayed 2 hours for inclement weather we will transport your students on the same delay providing you have school (example 2 hours later from regular time). If we run regular time and you are on a delay, we will not have the ability to bring your students in 2 hours later because our buses will still be running elementary students to school. Those days, parents will need to provide transportation in the AM and we will be able to transport them home as usual.

Policy for transportation on days we are not in school:

We use a hub transfer method in the morning to get your students to school. They ride in on one of our 20+ buses and then transfer to the specific bus to be taken to each particular Charter Non-public school. If you are in school but we are not, because of our hub and transfer method and all our buses are not out to pick students up and bring them to the transfer point, it would be impossible to have the same times and pickup points and just causes confusion. On those days, if parents could bring their students to the JR High to get on a bus @7:25-7:28 then we would go to South elementary and students could board there @ 7:35 -7:39 we would be happy to take your students to school from there. Another option would be that parents could transport themselves on those days for AM. The PM Ride home on those days will be normal.
